Message from the Chair

Happy New Year Fellow Quality Associates!!!!!!

We are officially into 2016! We have amazing plans for the 2016 year, so please continue going to our website, reading our emails, and ATTENDING OUR MEETINGS!!!! We appreciate each and every one of you! It was a pleasure speaking last month about creating your very own culture of Quality. This is a task faced by many Quality leaders, as we tend to be the Change Agents within our organization. You can find that presentation on our website, www.asqtampabay.org, along with many other presentations that have been given over the years. As we continue on our journey through the keys to sustaining a supplier certification program, we left off with discussing Step 1 of the keys.

Step 2: How are suppliers chosen for the parts or service being purchased? Prior to beginning Step 2, you have identified and/or reviewed the requirements that you need from your supplier. Now that you have those items identified, how do you go about choosing the appropriate supplier? In my previous lives, I have seen cost and delivery being the only determining factor in which supplier is going to be THE CHOSEN supplier. NOOOOOOO!!!! While cost and delivery are extremely important, they are not the only elements in deciding which company is going to supply product for you. What types of products does the organization produce or sell? What is their expertise? Are they only a distributor for this product? What is their customer service level? What do other customers say about the product they supply? What is the quality of the product that they typically supply? What part are they supplying and where does this product go into? Are they ISO certified? All of these questions are important questions and should be addressed prior to choosing the supplier. Many large organizations have teams of Supplier Performance specialists that will perform an audit, handle the contract negotiations, and project planning. However, this is not the norm and many small organizations do not have the resources to provide such a service. If you are an organization that does not have the resources, a simple discussion during the review of these requirements will help to determine which supplier should be chosen. All of the questions referenced above should be asked during that discussion. There may also be an ASL or AVL (Approved Supplier List or Approved Vendor List) that buyers can pull from based on the commodity that is being sourced. However, there must be steps that answer the previous questions that would allow them to be added to such a list.

In closing, how are the suppliers within your organization chosen? Are they determined by Engineering, Purchasing, and/or Quality. Are they determined by cost and delivery alone? If they are determine by cost and delivery alone, how is that working for you? ;-) Feel free to reach out to me for any questions regarding this step in the process.




ASQ Certification for St. Petersburg/Tampa Section 1508

- Responsible for Company's Document Control System
- Leads company in understanding, promoting and implementation of defect prevention methodologies and practices to minimize scrap, internal and external quality rejections. Effectively uses, as appropriate, Failure Mode & Effects Analysis as a living document to drive improvement.
- Interfaces with Engineering & Sales to ensure effective quality planning and development and maintenance of effective quality instructions including job programs and control plans.
- Facilitates training of all appropriate personnel on quality requirements of new programs and changes to existing programs.
- Facilitates effective corrective action to eliminate/reduce scrap and Internal Non-conformance Reports
- Reviews and analyzes scrap produced in production and drives improvement before issues result in rejections
- Facilitates problem solving and coordinates containment, sorting and issuance of RMAs in the event of customer complaints. Ensure corrective action responses are submitted to the customer on-time.
- Ensures prompt communication of quality issues to appropriate associates, ensures agreed upon corrective actions are implemented and ensures actions taken are effective.
- Maintains regular and proactive involvement with customers (along with Program Management). Works to develop
 positive relationships with customers. Principal contact/Liaison between customer and Sun Microstamping for all
 quality issues.
- Analyzes all customer returns for disposition and determine if additional corrective action is required.
- Proactively works with the customer to provide clear accept/reject criteria for the production floor. Familiar with function and application of individual parts and communicates function to work force.
- Leads customer specific improvement initiatives resulting from line accumes, customer audits and increases in internal or external rejections


