Speaker: Jaime Villafuerte Lean Six Sigma Director - Jabil, Inc

Topic: Lean Six Sigma Transformation: Making it to stick

Main Speaker: Jaime Villafuerte, Lean Six Sigma Director

<u>Summary</u>: Despite of all the resources and efforts that many organizations have committed to become Lean Six Sigma, evidence of truly successful transformation are scared. A recent large survey found that only 2 percent of companies that have a Lean Six Sigma program achieved their anticipated results. Even more, the Shingo Prize and the National Quality Baldrige organizations that give awards for operational excellence, went back to past winners and found that many had failed to sustain their progress.

Why is so difficult? Why to many failed? What can we do?

This presentation will address these questions and provide insight look of how Jabil, a 130,000+ employee company with HQ in Saint Petersburg, is facing these challenge.

<u>Speaker Bio</u>: Jaime has 18 years of experience in designing, managing and leading lean enterprise transformations in the Americas, Europe and Asia. As Lean Six Sigma Director at Jabil, Inc, Jaime leads the learning and development strategy and deployment reaching more than 120,000 employees in 27 countries. Jaime holds a BS in industrial engineering and master from University of Florida. He is currently at MIT Executive MBA program. He is an ASQ Certified Master Black Belt and Lean Gold Certified by SME, AME and Shingo Prize.

Jaime is the author of the Lean Six Sigma Deployment Memory Jogger®, participated in several ASQ, AME and IIE conferences as a presenter and has served as a Baldrige National Award Examiner in 2010.


