Topic: "Health Systems Safety, Alert Fatigue and Robotics"

Main Speaker: Nick Cablio, Quality Data Manager at James A Haley, VA

<u>Summary</u>: In his presentation, Nick will speak about Health Systems safety, alert fatigue and robotics. In 1999 the institute of medicine made headlines when they published "to err is human" which included the alarming statistic that up to 98,000 Americans died each year from preventable medical mistakes. A great deal of effort was made to improve system performance with the result that recent studies have indicated this number has climbed to over 400,000 preventable deaths per year due to some kind of medical error. This would make such mistakes the third leading cause of death in the United States. It was thought that incorporating computer assisted physician order entry would reduce errors.

While it reduced some, a new type of mistake was being triggered. This presentation will look at the impact of computer systems and robotics on medical mistakes.

Speaker Bio: Nicholas Coblio has a BS in Pharmacy from the Philadelphia College of Pharmacy, a Masters degree in Engineering Management, essentially an MBA for Enqineers, a Masters Certificate in Quality Management and a PhD in Engineering Science from USF. He has a certificate as a Black Belt in Six Sigma from St. Pete College, an ASQ Certified Black Belt in Six Sigma, and is a licensed pharmacist in the state of Florida.

Nick is the Quality/Data Manager for the pharmacy department at the James A Haley VA in Tampa, a position he has held tor the last 25 years. He has published papers on the use of large databases for monitoring health outcomes as well as monitoring system performance. His research interests include application of human factors to health system safety, specifically the impact of alert fatigue on health care providers and responses to system alerts.

Nick is a licensed private pilot who is envious of his son, a US Air Force Aircraft Commander who gets to fly C-17's.

Topic: "ASQ Performance Awards and Recognition Program (PAR)"

Summary: In his presentation, Michael will speak about the ASQ Performance Awards and Recognition (PAR) program. PAR is the new model for member units (divisions and sections) to use for planning and implementing activities designed to drive higher-levels of member engagement.

This engagement results from a renewed focus on improved member satisfaction and loyalty as well as member unit retention and growth rates. It replaces the now -retired Quality Management Process (QMP).

Speaker Bio: Michael Kirchner has worked for over 30 years in Quality Assurance. His professional career began with the Defense Logistics Agency, then on to IBM Federal Systems, Loral Federal Systems, Lockheed Martin, Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC), and Leidos. He is currently Director Product Assurance for Mission Systems Integration Operation of Leidos in Orlando, FL.

Michael earned an MS/Information Systems Degree from the Naval Postgraduate School. Michael holds ASQ certifications as CQA and CMQ/OE, and is a SSMBB (Harrington Institute). He has Lead Auditor Training in ISO 9001:2008 and AS9100C.


