<u>Summary</u>: Dr. Inozu Has more than 20 years of performance-improvement experience in government and the healthcare, maritime, and maintenance, repair, and overhaul (MRO) industries. He led more than 20 major applied research projects and wrote more than 70 journal articles and conference papers.

Previously, he held the positions of Professor and Chairman of the School of Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering of the School of Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering, and Professor in the Engineering Management Department at the University of New Orleans. He was also the Director of the Reliability, Operations, and Maintenance Division of Gulf Coast Region Maritime Technology Center for more than 10 years.

<u>Speaker Bio</u>: Dr. Inozu is a co-author of "Performance Improvement for Health-care: Leading Change with Lean, Six Sigma and Constraints Management" (McGraw-Hill 2011). He is a Lean Six Sigma Master Black Belt and a Theory of Constraints Jonah.


