Speaker: Kevin Gerrish
Director of Operations, Conax Florida Corporation

Topic: *Change Management - Bringing LEAN into an Organization*

Come out to hear this great speaker and topic - Kevin Gerrish will be our main speaker. He will be speaking on how to bring Lean (6-sigma) principles into an organization from strategic direction to tactical implementation. He will share with us stories and results from the, currently in-process, Lean transformation of Conax Florida Corporation. He will provide insight on setting up value streams, integrating Supply Chain, Manufacturing, Engineering, Quality, Finance and Business Development.

Kevin Gerrish is currently the Director of Operations, Conax Florida Corporation. His education credentials include BSEE from Rochester Institute of Technology and MBA from Pepperdine University. He has 14 US Patents to his credit. He is also the member IEEE and Tau Beta Pi Nat'l Engineering Honor Society, served on Board of Directors for Arnold Electronics, Electrical Engineering Department Advisory Board for RIT, Professor for a Day Program CA State Univ at Fullerton, and Officer at Christ the King Lutheran Church.

His Professional Focus and interests include Forecasting / Modeling, LEAN (front/back office, manufacturing, supply chain, etc.), and Electronics / Embedded Control Systems.

Pre-dinner Topic – *How Social Networking can drive Innovation & Improvement in an Organization by Patricia Farley*

Patricia Farley has recently relocated from Chicago, where she was an ASQ section board member and earned her CQIA. Patricia graduated from Kent State University with a BS degree in biology and completed the Lean Master Facilitator certification from the Milwaukee School of Engineering. She began work as a production chemist in an environmental laboratory owned by Corning and learned TQM. Later, Patricia worked in a diversity of manufacturing environments in quality control, quality assurance and quality engineering. Patricia helped implement ISO 9001:2000 at the Ace Hardware Corp. Paint Division plants and most recently, Patricia served as the Sears Region Quality Manager overseeing the QMS ISO 9001:2000 for 10 product repair service centers coast to coast.

Patricia will discuss what social networking is, provide evidence why social networking is an important consideration, share a case study and finally some topics to consider as a company embraces such technology.

Message from the Chair

Once again, Guerry Thode, our Placement Chair, shared with us a few of his job hunting/career choosing techniques that he has gained from many years of personal experience. Guerry challenged us to answer the following questions, before we embark on a career quest: who am I, what are my skills, what are my gifts, what is my personality, and what value can I bring to an organization. Guerry told us to focus on what we like to do and what fulfills us; he also encouraged us to develop our personal brand and to write it down in seven words. With many other nuggets, Guerry's speech on the "Ten Job-search Tips for 2010," was well received and right on point for the current job climate.

Our main speaker of the night was Mr. Tom Kubiak, President and Founder of Performance Improvement Solutions. Mr. Kubiak, an experienced and well known educator in several quality related areas, delivered an enlightening presentation on "Developing Meaningful Metrics: Driving Action for Results!" Tom spoke about the difference between measures and indicators, pitfalls to avoid, and key characteristics of good measures. Tom's presentation was well illustrated with examples. My only disappointment, which was echoed by other members, is that we could not continue the night's presentation with the seminar entitled "How *Not* to Implement Lean Six Sigma: Lessons Learned from the Trenches," which Mr. Kubiak would be teaching on the next day; unfortunately, the course had to be cancelled prior his arrival.

Just in the last couple of months, Toyota recalled millions of vehicles due to gas pedal issues related to a potentially dangerous acceleration. Honda recalled several thousands of automobiles due to window switches that can overheat if exposed to liquid, causing smoke, melting or even a fire. Becton, Dickinson and Company's recalled certain Q-Syte Luers and Catheter Systems which may result in serious injury or death. Johnson & Johnson recalled several over-the-counter drugs including Tylenol, Motrin and St. Joseph's aspirin because of a moldy smell that has made people sick. These recalls intrigue me because they are all the result of defective products developed by great companies with many resources and armies of quality professionals. It appears to me that we don't need "more" quality, what we need is "better" quality. What do you think?
