Speaker: Phil Thomas

Topic: Calibration Myths, Misunderstandings & Mistakes - How Not to Worry about Calibration in Your Next ISO Audit

The program takes a twelve-step approach to preparing the job seeker with the tools necessary to successfully find the next opportunity. In 2009, he co-authored his book "A Road Map To Re-Employment; 12-steps to a successful career transition." Additionally, in December 2010, he and his wife started Guardian College Funding Consultants. Having spent a considerable amount of time with their college age son, as well as college planning with Rob's clients, they understand the trials and tribulations of college funding and the need for proper planning.


2. In the Status column, click Cancel Registration icon.


